Health Support Program A Free General Medical & Eye Camp was organized at Gudiyatham Village in Vellore district on 28th Oct 2017, in the premises of our local partner there. This place is 120 miles away from Chennai city and is surrounded with 1000 families of daily laborers. This Free Medical Camp was facilitated by 4 doctors and 7 nurses of General medicine, Dental, Dermatology, Eye & Diabetes care to examine, prescribe free medicines and to provide further treatment for those in need from CMC Hospital, Vellore with the support of Ida Scudder Memorial Hospital, Ranipet. A total of 130 individuals from the age of 5 to 80 years attended this camp and were examined and given medicines.



Ten patients were given free spectacles after examining and 6 patients were advised and supported for cataract surgery. Those attended were happy about us organizing such a camp closer to their homes.

We thank CMC Hospital and Ida Scudder Memorial Hospital for supporting this medical camp, as it helped many poor to uplift their lives by caring for their physical well-being.

Micro programs to break the cycle of poverty:

One day Micro skill development program was organized at Timiri Village of Vellore District on 6th Oct 2017. 10 women participated and they were taught to make wire baskets, creatively design with woolen thread, prepare masala powders, idly powder, curry powder and tomato pickle.

At Padapai village in Kanchipuram District 5 day's Micro skill development program was conducted from 8th to 12th Dec 2017 for 10 women. The participants were taught to make chemical products such as, Surf Powder, Phenoyl, Dish washing powder and Robin blue. They were also taught to make candles.

These were taught for them to make some extra money from home. All were excited and confident to make these products on their own to make some extra money to transform their lives.

Testimony:

My name is Suganya. I am a house wife living in the village of Padapai. I heard about the skill training to be provided near my home for free and I enrolled to the program. The training on making Chemical Products impressed and motivated me to learn these skills with utmost care. I got the raw materials for preparing surf powder and phenoyl even before the training period completed and prepared these products taught, on my own, with the support of the trainer. It was so simple to learn and do. I never thought that I would get an opportunity like this. Going forward, these kills will help me to increase my family income. I thank God and Ebendavid Charities for organization such a program in our village.

2.Skill Development Centres: Skill development centres are set up in various locations to provide skill development courses for the unemployed, poor and destitute women/children, for these people living in poverty to transform their lives

Our Tailoring skill development centres have capacity to train 456 women in a year. And we have requests to start skill development centres in Visakkapatnam (Andhra Pradesh), Veepur (Vellore), Vannivedu (Arcot) and other parts of Tamilnadu. Payment to a trainer to start one location is **Rs.2500** per month. We solicit sponsors to add more centres to the benefit of more women.

"My name is A. Durga. I am housewife and I live in the village of Ambajipeta of Andhra Pradesh. I came to know that free tailoring course is offered and I enrolled to the program on 25.4.17 and the course ended on 10.11.17. By completing this tailoring course, I learnt to stitch Chudithar, Blouse and Kids dresses. Now I have started my own tailoring business from home. I am greatly thankful to Ebendavid Charities for providing this free tailoring course to a poor like me."

"My name is Valli from Padappai village, Kanchipuram District. I got an opportunity to join the free tailoring course on 20.3.17 and the course completed on 16.9.17. This training course of 6 months has developed my skills in cutting and stitching of Blouse, Children's Dress and Chudithar. This training program also helped me to get employed and now I am working for a Garment Factory earning Rs.6000 per month. I thank God and Ebendavid Charities for providing such a great opportunity to develop my skills."
